How To Use Your Scripture Meditations

Each of your Bible lessons is a 7 day journey. On *Day 1* you will complete the week's Bible study. You will only be using your scripture meditations on the days that you do not do a Bible Study—**Days 2-7 of each week**—To take the scripture truths you learned deeper into your heart.

Step 1:

Print your scripture cards. *Optional:* You can print them on card stock, laminate them, or glue them to index cards to make them sturdier for long-term use after the course.

Step 2:

Each week, place that week's scriptures somewhere noticeable. *Examples:* put them in your purse or wallet, or tape them to your mirror, alarm clock, refrigerator, computer screen, etc.

Step 3:

Read your scriptures a minimum of twice each day (before bed and upon rising). For advanced users, spend 5-10 minutes reading and praying over on the weeks scriptures once each week.

***To get the most out of the *Becoming God's Masterpiece* Program, combine all 3 Steps each week: Bible study, prayer, and scripture meditation.**
