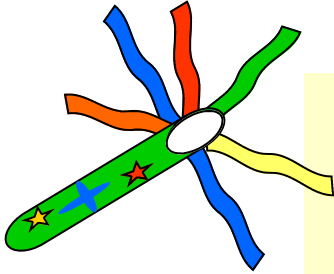


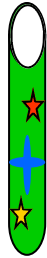
# Make A Paper Towel Roll Praise Banner!

Easy and Great for Smaller Kids!



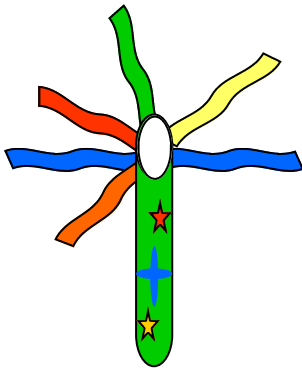
## What You Will Need:

- Empty paper towel roll
  - Hole puncher
- 5-10 colorful ribbons
- Construction paper
  - Glue
- Decorating Utensils (crayons, and/or markers, colored pencils, finger paint, glitter)
- Small jingle bells (Optional)



## Step One: Decorate!

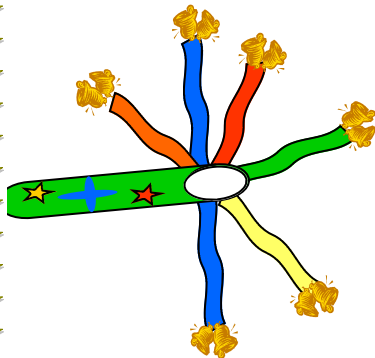
- Pick which color construction paper you will use to cover your coffee can or oatmeal box
- Decorate the construction paper with pictures that give glory to God!
- Glue your construction paper around your empty paper towel roll.



## Step 2: Add Streamers!

Now it is time to make your paper towel roll into a praise banner!

- Punch 5-10 holes around the top of your roll.
- Pick one ribbon.
- Thread it through a hole on your roll.
- Pull the ribbon through until both sides are the same length. Then, tie a knot to secure it.
- Do the same thing for each of the holes that you punched.



## Final Step: Finishing Touch!

Now it is time to add your finishing touches if you'd like. You can make your praise banner into a musical instrument!

- Tie very small jingle bells to the end of each ribbon.
- Now, when you wave your praise banner, the bells will jingle in praise to God!

# Make A Coffee Can Praise Drum!

Easy and Great for Smaller Kids!



## What You Will Need:

- Empty Coffee Can or Oatmeal box with plastic lid
  - Construction paper
  - Glue
- Decorating Utensils (crayons, and/or markers, colored pencils, finger paint, glitter)

Plastic Lid



## Step One: Decorate!

- Pick which color construction paper you will use to cover your coffee can or oatmeal box
- Decorate the construction paper with pictures that give glory to God!
- Glue your construction paper around your can.
- Place the lid on top of the can. It is the top of your drum!



## Step 2: Add Sound!

The lid will help to give your coffee can drum sound. To make your drum make noise, just tap it with your hands and fingers!

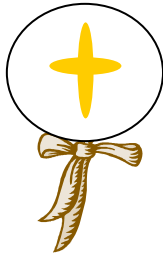
## Final Step: Finishing Touch!

Now it is time to add your finishing touches if you'd like. If you want to add even more sound to your coffee can drum, try using some of these to create sound!

- Unsharpened pencils or markers
- 2 rulers
- Wooden spoons
- Wooden sticks

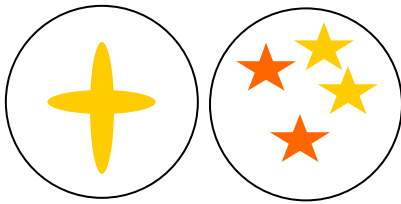


# Make A Paper Plate Tambourine to Praise God!



## What You Will Need:

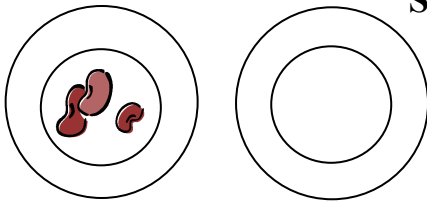
- 2 Paper Plates
- 1/4 cup Dried Beans
- Glue or Stapler
- Ribbon or string (optional)
- Decorating Utensils (crayons, and/or markers, colored pencils, finger paint, glitter)



## Step One: Decorate!

Decorate the rounded side of your two plates to make your tambourine unique! You can use:

- Markers
- Finger paints
- Glitter etc.



## Step 2: Add Sound!

Now it is time to add your dried beans!

- Add about 1/4 cup of dried beans to the center of your bottom plate, right where you would normally put your food.
- Place your second plate on top, with your decorated side facing out.
- Staple or glue your plates together.

**Note:** If you glue the plates, you will need to wait for them to dry before use. But, staples may not be safe for small children.



## Final Step: Finishing Touch!

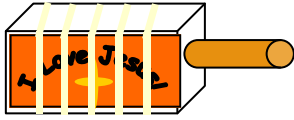
Now it is time to add your finishing touches if you'd like.

Consider tying ribbon or yarn at the bottom of your tambourine.

- Using a hole puncher, make a small hole at the bottom of your tambourine.
- String the pretty ribbon or colorful string through the hole.
- Tie it into a bow the bottom.

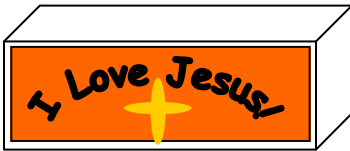
*Use this same method to tie LOTS of small ribbons all around your tambourine so that they wave as you praise!*

# Make A Shoe Box Guitar to Praise God With!



## What You Will Need:

- Shoe Box
- Rubber Bands
- Construction paper
  - Glue
- Empty paper towel roll (optional)
- Decorating Utensils (crayons, and/or markers, colored pencils, finger paint, glitter)



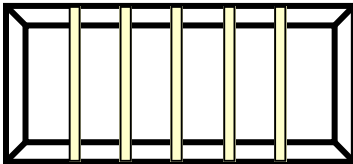
## Step One: Decorate!

- Pick which color construction paper you will use to cover your shoe box.
- Decorate the construction paper with pictures that give glory to God!
- Glue your construction paper to your shoe box

*Optional:* You may want to glue your construction paper to your shoebox after you have added the rubber bands in step 2. This way, your rubber bands will not cover your beautiful design!

## Step 2: Add Sound!

- Find 5 Large rubber bands
- Stretch each rubber band around your decorated shoebox to create the guitar strings!



## Final Step: Finishing Touch!

Now it is time to add your finishing touches if you'd like. Consider gluing an empty paper towel roll to the side of your shoebox guitar. It can be a great handle!
